2.	Did any of your research make you more/less likely to continue your education beyond high school? If so, what information helped you decide?

If so, does this information make a difference in your future plans?
4. Did you decide to stay on your planned career path or go in a different direction? Why?
5.	Is the thought of making a lot of money in your career more or less important to you than a career where you might make less money but get more satisfaction from the work you do? What if you could have both?
